1 - Need and mission statement

- The ASEAN Plan of Action for Energy Sector Cooperation stresses that
 - Participation of the ASEAN private or business sector, ASEAN Dialogue Partners and the relevant National / International organisations shall be encouraged

- Need a platform to be "*the trusted voice of the private sector*" for dialogue:
 - Amongst private sector players, Vis à vis public authorities, Internationally

- VISION and MISSION: P.15



1 - Strategic approach and priorities

- No Duplication of work undertaken by existing structures:
 - The subsector networks, ACE, the utilities networks

- Conduit of the Private sector to provide input to policy formulations and discussions:
 - Supporting national organisations, Inputting to ACE / SOE

- Platform for added value, exchange of views on technologies and business models to private sector members

- Priority strategic sectors identified, which will mobilise the private sector, and services of interest to stakeholders
 - Renewables, priority on biomass, including biofuels, and waste;
 - Project / investment financing;



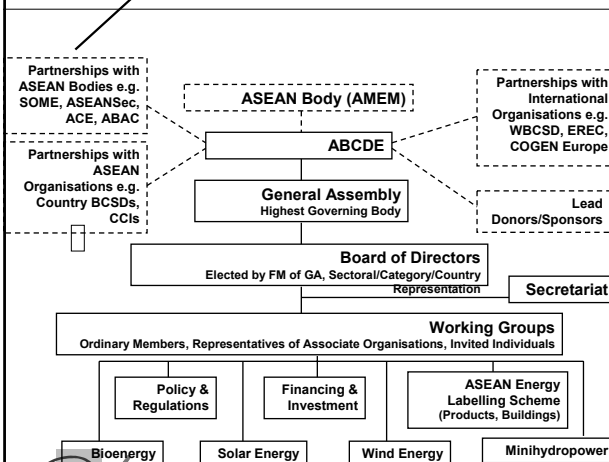


3 – Proposed Governance mode and structure

- To be part of the ASEAN Family
- With Country focal points – needs further elaboration

4 – Short and long term sustainability issues

- ❑ In the short term: organisation
 - Up to effective launching of the Council, some activities are needed such as incorporation,
 - Agreed in Manila that these would be conducted by a Pro Tem Committee ...
 - Supported by ACE as secretariat to ensure continuity(Lara Bertarelli)

- ❑ In the short term / medium term : financial sustainability
 - Supporting Pro tem: voluntary basis from “champions”
 - Need core financing for the first year priority action plan: high visibility to mobilise the private sector
 - Minimum core staff and logistics to be supported: how large
 - where to mobilise the resources?
 - Sponsors: immediate membership fees
 - ACE? Donors – possibilities for cofunding are being explored



3 – Short and long term sustainability issues

- ❑ Road Map beyond the Pro tem
 - Priority mobilisation of team
 - Priority actions to mobilise the Private sector during year 1
 - Council can provide income generating services and events should provide income
 - Substance: revised and credible yearly action plan... (Tuan Nguyen) biomass & financing events, database, information services, newsletter *complementary with ACE.*
