 - The subsector networks, ACE, the utilities networks
- ☐ Conduit of the Private sector to provide input to policy formulations and discussions:
 - Supporting national organisations, Inputting to ACE / SOE
- Platform for added value, exchange of views on technologies and business models to private sector members
- Priority strategic sectors identified, which will mobilise the private sector, and services of interest to stakeholders
 - Renewables, priority on biomass, including biofuels, and waste;
 - Project / investment financing;


Proposed Governance mode and structure

- ☐ In the short term: organisation
 - Up to effective launching of the Council, some activities are needed such as incorporation,
 - Agreed in Manila that these would be conducted by a Pro Tem Committee ...
 - Supported by ACE as secretariat to ensure continuity(Lara Bertarelli)
- ☐ In the short term / medium term : financial sustainability
 - Supporting Pro tem: voluntary basis from "champions"
 - Need core financing for the first year priority action plan: high visibility to mobilise the private sector
 - Minimum core staff and logistics to be supported: how large
 - where to mobilise the resources?
 - Sponsors: immediate membership fees
 - ACE? Donors possibilities for cofunding are being explored
