
- Ambition Reach 1 Million people by 2015


Macro: Whom to reach: Electricity (source: IEA)



Macro: Where to reach: Electricity (source: IEA)




Micro: Actual Rural Electricity Demand






Micro: Efforts towards Rural Solutions








Product Innovation and Planning Check on actors, products and practices



EASE Energy Access Strategy



- define energy solution for end-users (check on local practices)
- 2. develop business package with regional energy service provider (check on products)
- sector up-scaling with (supra-) regional distributor (check with actors)

4. supporting institutions, training, planning and policies (check with planners)


